2. Therapeutic Supervision: Court-ordered family reunification, this service provides a supportive environment to facilitate healing and bonding. \$240 for 2-hours (\$120 billed to insurance if accepted)
3. Guided Supervision: Focuses on goal setting for parents and children. It includes co-parenting goal setting and detailed case notes to track progress toward these goals, which are established based on assessments. The cost is \$85 per hour.
